Northern Oil Refinery (NOR), located at Yarwun outside of Gladstone, is the only facility in Queensland capable of recycling waste lube oil back into base lube oil*. Pructon was engaged to design and construct four blending tanks to hold fuel at the Northern Oil site in Gladstone. The tanks have a 270,000-litre holding capacity, and the project included associated pipe work.

The tanks were fabricated and painted at the Pructon Gladstone mechanical workshop facility and transported to the site where they were lifted into position.

- Design and certification of the tanks
- Fabrication in our Gladstone workshop of four tanks that stood 20m high and 5m in diameter
- Surface treatment of the tanks and then cladding
- Transporting under escort to the site and unloading
- Fabrication and installation of pipe, valves and pumps
- Standing the tanks and landing on their footings
- Hydrostatic test and commissioning of the tanks and pipe work
